



**A RESOLUTION OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, KANSAS TO AUTHORIZE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A
WORK-RELEASE PROGRAM;**

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners desires to provide county inmates with opportunities to maintain employment, support families, assist in the payment of fines and penalties to the court, and promote a successful return to the community, and;

WHEREAS, Kansas statute provides that a Board of County Commissioners may, by resolution, authorize the establishment of a work-release program, and;

WHEREAS, Kansas statute provides that inmates who voluntarily participate in such a program shall be required to pay to the county a fee not exceeding \$20 per day to defray costs of maintaining such inmate in the county jail, and;

WHEREAS, assessed fees may be reduced or waived in instances in which payment would create an undue hardship for the inmate, and;

WHEREAS, all fees collected from inmates participating in the work release program shall be deposited in the county treasury and credited to the general fund, as a Jail reimbursement, and;

WHEREAS, The County Sheriff, County Attorney, and District Court all support the implementation of such a program, and;

WHEREAS, The Sheriff has adopted policies necessary to properly manage such a program;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY
THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY**

The Franklin County Sheriff shall be and hereby is authorized to establish and operate a work-release program for and within the County.
