



**A RESOLUTION TO VACATE A PORTION OF BUTLER TERRACE EAST OF UTAH ROAD IN
FRANKLIN COUNTY, KANSAS**

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Commission authorized notice of proposed vacation of Beginning in Section 8, Township 19 South, Range 21 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Franklin County, Kansas; Thence East approximately 2,000 feet to the end at approximately 4400 Butler Terrace.

WHEREAS, the Notice of Public Hearing was published in the official county newspaper on January 21st and January 28th, 2026; and

WHEREAS, notice of the proposed vacation was mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested, to all landowners of record as required by K.S.A. 68-102 notifying said landowners of the proposed vacation and of their right to protest said vacation; and

WHEREAS, a hearing was held on February 4, 2026 for anyone wishing to protest the vacation of said particular road; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY
THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY**

That the following road is not a public utility by reason of neglect, non-use, or inconvenience and that said road has become practically impassable and the necessity for said road as a public utility does not justify the expenditure of the necessary funds to repair said road or put the same in condition for public travel and therefore said road is hereby vacated as follows:

Beginning 850 feet East of the Southwest Corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section 8, Township 19 South, Range 21 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Franklin County, Kansas; Thence East approximately 2,000 feet to the Southeast Corner of said Southwest Quarter.

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect following its passage by the Board of County Commissioners and its subsequent publication in the official county newspaper.

This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and shall remain in effect until future action is taken by the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners.
