To Whom It May Concern:

The Franklin County Commission wishes to inform the City of Ottawa that the Franklin County Transfer Station, 3323 Osborne Terrace, will have a spring cleanup on April 3rd and April 4th for residents inside the city limits. Roll-off dumpsters will be placed in specified areas during those days for use by residents living inside the city limits of Ottawa.

We are offering this service to reduce the volume of waste coming into the Transfer Station on April 25th and 26th. This will allow the City to have clean-up before the Transfer Station is open to the public on those days.

The Transfer Station will NOT be open to the public for free dumping on April 3rd and April 4th.

We will only be accepting roll-off containers for free dumping during this time period. The roll-off containers filled on Friday and Saturday will be allowed to dump commencing Friday, April 3rd through Tuesday, April 7th.

Please, make plans now to take part in this endeavor as we would like to see everyone participate. In sending this letter early we hope you will be able to distribute this information to your city residents.

The Transfer Station will be open to the public for free dumping on Friday, April 24th from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and Saturday, April 25th from 8:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

Restrictions on dumping include the following:

- ❖ **NO appliances with Freon.**
- ❖ **Tires, oil, gas tanks, burned trash residue, or liquids will not be accepted.**
- ❖ **Attention: Please do not allow boats to be put in the roll off dumpsters.**
- Household hazardous waste such as oil-based paint (NO LATEX), batteries, chemicals, etc. are collected at no charge at the Franklin County Noxious Weed Dept, Monday thru Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
