BOARD OF FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS REORGANIZATION MEETING

Meeting Location: Franklin County Annex Building Commission Chambers

Chair Waymire called the meeting to order at 8:30a.m.

Roll call: Chair Colton Waymire present, Vice Chair Ianne Dickinson present, Commissioner Donald Stottlemire present, Commissioner Rod Harris absent, Commissioner Roy C. Dunn present.

Chair Waymire asked all in attendance to stand and join him in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Invocation was led by Pastor Scott Dickinson, Franklin County Detention Center Chaplain.

Chair Waymire adjourned the current commission at 8:33a.m.

Commissioner Waymire reconvened the new session of the Franklin County Board of Commissioners.

All Commissioners were present except Commissioner Harris.

Commissioner Stottlemire nominated Commissioner Dunn as the Chairperson. Commissioner Dunn said he would accept the position. He discussed how many years he has been on the Commission.

Commissioner Stottlemire moved and Commissioner Waymire seconded to elect Commissioner Roy Dunn as the Chairperson for the 2022 session. All voted "yes" except Commissioner Dunn abstained.

Commissioner Stottlemire nominated Commissioner Dickinson as the Vice Chairperson. Commissioner Dickinson said she would accept the position.

Commissioner Stottlemire moved and Commissioner Waymire seconded to elect Commissioner Ianne Dickinson as the Vice Chairperson for the 2022 session. All voted "yes" except Commissioner Dickinson abstained.

The Commissioners discussed the meeting times. They discussed continuing on the same schedule of Study Sessions every other Monday and regular meetings every Wednesday both at 8:30a.m. The Commissioners felt the meeting schedule should remain the same with an occasional meeting in the evening when warranted.
