BOARD OF FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

Meeting Location: Franklin County Annex Building Commission Chambers

Chair Meador called the meeting to order at 8:30a.m.

Roll call: Chair Sabrina Meador present, Vice Chair Rod Harris absent, Commissioner Donald Stottlemire present, Commissioner Ianne Dickinson present, Commissioner Colton Waymire present.

Chair Meador asked all in attendance to stand and join her in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Invocation was led by Pastor Leonard Cheasbro

Public Comment:

Norman Wooge- 3790 Pawnee Rd, Ottawa- discussed being able to go on the road tour study session. He also discussed concerns over a commissioner missing some meetings.

Commissioner Waymire moved and Commissioner Stottlemire seconded to consent agenda as follows: claim vouchers in the amount of \$2,081,862.59, tax change orders in the amount of -\$18,393.45, minutes from the meeting on January 12, 2026, minutes from the study session on January 14, 2026, and minutes from the study session January 14, 2026. All voted "yes" except Commissioner Harris abstained from all of the minutes.

Jeff Richards, Sheriff, discussed the Pomona Law Enforcement contract for 2026. The contract is an annual agreement between the County Commissioners and the Pomona City Council to allow the Franklin County Sheriff's Department to provide law enforcement services in the City of Pomona. The Contract allows for 40 hours of dedicated services at a cost of \$85,296 for 2026.

Commissioner Dickinson moved and Commissioner Harris seconded to approve the 2026 Pomona Law Enforcement contract, in the amount of \$85,296. All voted "yes".

Jeff Welton, Public Works Director, discussed the purchase of an in-frame engine rebuild for a 2006 Peterbilt 357 Semi. The truck is used to pull the department's lowboy trailer. The chassis remains in good condition after 475K miles despite the engine problems of the unit. Staff recommends replacing the engine that includes a 4-year extended warranty in the amount of \$34,419.00.

Commissioner Waymire moved and Commissioner Harris seconded to approve the in-frame engine rebuild with the 4 year extended warranty for truck #46 also known as a 2006 Peterbilt 357 Semi in the amount of \$31,419.00. All voted "yes".

Staff reports were given by Pat Toth, Planning Director; and Paul Bean, FCDC Director.

Commissioner Harris moved and Commissioner Waymire seconded to adjourn the meeting at 8:44a.m. All voted "yes".
