BOARD OF FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

Meeting Location: Franklin County Annex Building Commission Chambers

Chair Meador called the meeting to order at 8:30a.m.

Roll call: Chair Sabrina Meador present, Vice Chair Rod Harris absent, Commissioner Donald Stottlemire present, Commissioner Ianne Dickinson present, Commissioner Colton Waymire present.

Chair Meador asked all in attendance to stand and join her in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Comment:

Jessica Christopher, 2355 Nebraska Rd, Ottawa- thanked the Commissioners for listening to the citizens regarding the potential of wind and solar projects in the county.

Commissioner Dickinson moved and Commissioner Waymire seconded to approve the consent agenda as follows: minutes from the meeting on January 28, 2026, claim vouchers in the amount of \$249,539.27, special claim vouchers in the amount of \$8,347.00, payroll in the amount of \$1,660,292.40, and the solicitation of Noxious Weed Chemicals. All voted "yes".

Jeff Welton, Public Works Director, discussed the need to open a public hearing to discuss vacating 2000 feet of Butler Terrace from a point of 965' east of Utah Road going east.

Commissioner Waymire moved and Commissioner Harris seconded to open a public hearing at 8:34a.m. All voted "yes".

No one from the public was present to comment on the proposed vacation of 2000 feet of Butler Terrace from a point of 965' east of Utah Road going east.

Commissioner Dickinson moved and Commissioner Waymire seconded to close the public hearing at 8:36a.m. All voted "yes".

The Commissioners expressed concerns that this vacation would landlock a piece of land. They discussed that the owner of the property should get an easement to secure the right to access his land in the future. Staff will make the recommendation to the landowner and bring this item back to the Commission for additional consideration.

Staff reports were given by Derek Brown, County Administrator, and Janet Paddock, County Clerk.

Commissioner Waymire moved and Commissioner Harris seconded to adjourn the meeting at 8:49a.m. All voted "yes".
