BOARD OF FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

Meeting Location: Franklin County Annex Building Commission Chambers

Chair Meador called the meeting to order at 8:30a.m.

Roll call: Chair Sabrina Meador present, Vice Chair Rod Harris absent, Commissioner Donald Stottlemire present, Commissioner Ianne Dickinson present, Commissioner Colton Waymire present.

Chair Meador asked all in attendance to stand and join her in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Invocation was led by Pastor Leonard Cheasbro.

Public Comment:

Warren Woods, 1473 Virginia Terr, Osawatomie- discussed concerns regarding snow removal on gravel roads. He said the gravel is being pushed into ditches and fields, and it can't be recovered to use on the roads.

Commissioner Waymire moved and Commissioner Harris seconded to approve the consent agenda as follows: minutes from the meeting on February 11, 2026, tax change orders in the amount of -\$2,711.66, and approve to offer the dust control program and solicit bids for dust control chemicals. All voted "yes".

DeAnn Farrell, Planning and Zoning Administrative Coordinator, discussed rezoning application #2511-0063 (Haslett) to rezone approximately 8.03 acres from the A-1, Agriculture District to the R-E, Residential Estate District. The property is commonly known as 1391 Reno Road. The Planning Department did not receive any communications for or against this rezoning, and the Planning Commission has forwarded a recommendation for approval.

Commissioner Dickinson moved and Commissioner Stottlemire seconded to adopt Resolution 26-07 to approve rezoning application #2511-0063 (Haslett) to rezone approximately 8.03 acres from the A-1, Agriculture District to the R-E, Residential Estate District and to amend the Official County Zoning Map accordingly. All voted "yes".

Staff reports were given by Derek Brown, County Administrator; Sarah Peffly, Emergency Communications Director; and Janet Paddock, County Clerk.

Commissioner Harris moved and Commissioner Dickinson seconded to adjourn the meeting at 9:06a.m. All voted "yes".
