BOARD OF FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

Meeting Location: Franklin County Annex Building Commission Chambers

Chair Dunn called the study session to order at 8:30 a.m.

All Commissioner were present.

Pam Harris, Assistant Health Department Director, discussed the master fee schedule for the Health Department, the change of reference Lab vendor and consideration of the COVID-19 vaccine administration fee. She discussed that the cost of supplies has increased since the last fee adjustment in the health department. The mission of the health department is to serve the underserved, and the adjusted fees will still be lower than other providers. The department would also like to start charging for the administration of the COVID-19 vaccine. They propose that the change begin on July 1st, and the department will bill insurance for the administration fee. The department would also like to change their reference lab to Quest Diagnostics. Quest is a provider for other offices in the building and already comes to the building daily. The current provider intends to start charging courier fees to pick up specimens from the Health Department. The Commissioners were agreeable to the changes, and the item will be placed on the Wednesday agenda.
