BOARD OF FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

Meeting Location: Franklin County Annex Building Commission Chambers

Chair Dunn called the meeting to order at 8:30a.m.

Roll call: Chair Roy C. Dunn present, Vice Chair Ianne Dickinson absent, Commissioner Donald Stottlemire absent, Commissioner Rod Harris present, Commissioner Colton Waymire present.

Chair Dunn asked all in attendance to stand and join him in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Invocation was led by Leonard Cheasbro, New Life in Christ Church, Ottawa.

No Public Comment.

Commissioner Harris moved and Commissioner Waymire seconded to approve the consent agenda as follows: minutes from the meeting on July 20, 2022 and special claim vouchers in the amount of \$8,550.00. All voted "yes".

W. David Lee, Public Works Director, discussed a request to set a date to hold a public hearing to vacate a portion of Labette Terrace from 4000 to 4100. The property owners were notified about zoning regulations that would prevent future building permits on the properties if the road was vacated. Kenneth Cook, Planning and Zoning Director, discussed the zoning regulations and how this property is impacted by this request. There would also be no public access to at least one property. The property owners will be notified again when the public hearing is set.

Commissioner Harris moved and Commissioner Waymire seconded to hold a Public Hearing on August 10, 2022 to consider vacating the 4000 to 4100 Block of Labette Terrace in the East Half of Section 12, Township 17 South, Range 20 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian, in Franklin County, Kansas. All voted "yes".

Staff reports were given by Derek Brown, County Administrator; Paul Bean, FCDC Director; Jeff Richards, Sheriff; W. David Lee, Public Works Director; and Janet Paddock, County Clerk.

Commissioner Harris moved and Commissioner Waymire seconded to adjourn the meeting at 9:11 a.m. All voted "yes".
