BOARD OF FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

Meeting Location: Franklin County Annex Building Commission Chambers

Chair Dunn called the study session to order at 8:30 a.m.

All Commissioners were present.

No Public Comment.

Sarah Peffly, Emergency Communications Director, discussed using RapidVideo to benefit the Emergency Communications Department. This technology would allow dispatch staff to initiate a one-way video call to get a better understanding of the situation that emergency staff will be seeing when they arrive on the scene. It would be up to dispatch staff to initiate the call if they feel it would be helpful. All video from RapidVideo will be hosted by the provider of the service and will be retained for one year. No new equipment is needed for this service. The Commissioners were supportive of this service.

W. David Lee, Public Works Director, discussed an in-house, entry-level driver training program to help county employees obtain their Commercial Driver's License. This program is necessary due to the change in laws governing the CDL process on February 7, 2022. The proposed program was developed by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration. A PowerPoint presentation will be used by the training staff to teach the class. 29 modules will be presented each with a practice exam and driving maneuver practice to follow. 10 employees have expressed interest, but the first class will be limited 2-3 so services are not negatively impacted. The Commissioners were supportive of this training opportunity.
