BOARD OF FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

Meeting Location: Franklin County Annex Building Commission Chambers

Chair Dunn called the meeting to order at 8:30a.m.

Roll call: Chair Roy C. Dunn present, Vice Chair Ianne Dickinson present, Commissioner Donald Stottlemire present, Commissioner Rod Harris present, Commissioner Colton Waymire present.

Chair Dunn asked all in attendance to stand and join him in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Invocation was led by Pastor Jared Yancey, Hope Anthem Church, Ottawa.

Ed Clark, Vice President of the Over the Road Gang Car Club, was in to express the car club's appreciation to the County for their support of the annual event. The show had 1,495 cars this year. He presented the Commissioners a plaque in appreciation.

Public Comment:

David C. Turner, 3652 Kentucky Road, Ottawa- brought a petition signed by land owners near the intersection of Kentucky Road and Sand Creek Road. The petition requested Kentucky Road be paved from Sand Creek Terrace south to the T at Osborne Terrace. He discussed the traffic from the Evergreen Mound Cemetery that creates a lot of dust when funeral processions go by.

Raymond Sundstrom, 2057 Sand Creek Road, Ottawa- expressed his support for black top to be added on Kentucky Road as discussed by David C. Turner.

The Commissioners discussed the area that was requested to be paved. The request was to pave 2 ½ miles. They asked W. David Lee, Public Works Director, what the cost per mile is to pave a road. He responded that a 4-inch asphalt is between \$1.2 million and \$1.5 million including road prep and acquiring right-of-way.

Commissioner Waymire moved and Commissioner Dickinson seconded to approve the consent agenda as follows: tax change orders in the amount of \$338.56 and minutes from the meeting on October 5, 2022. All voted "yes".

W. David Lee, Public Works Director, discussed vacating the 4000 to 4100 Block of Labette Terrace in the East Half of Section 12, Township 17 South, Range 20 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian. A public hearing was held on this matter on August 10, 2022, and the Commissioners suggested that the property owners involved prepare an easement to insure access to the properties that along the portion of road to be vacated. The easement has been signed and will be filed with the Register of Deeds Office after the road vacation is approved by the Commissioners.

Commissioner Stottlemire moved and Commissioner Dickinson seconded to adopt Resolution 22-36 to approve vacating the 4000 to 4100 Block of Labette Terrace in the East Half of Section 12, Township 17 South, Range 20 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian. All voted "yes".

Staff reports were given by Paul Bean, FCDC Director; Jeff Richards, Sheriff; W. David Lee, Public Works Director; and Janet Paddock, County Clerk.

Commissioner Waymire moved and Commissioner Dickinson seconded to enter into Executive Session under K.S.A. 75-4319 for the KOMA exception of Attorney Client Privilege for 15 minutes beginning at 9:17a.m. with the Board of County Commissioners and the County Counselor with the meeting resuming at 9:32a.m. All voted "yes".

The Commission reconvened at 9:32a.m. No action taken.

Commissioner Harris moved and Commissioner Waymire seconded to adjourn the meeting at 9:33a.m. All voted "yes".
