RESOLUTION NO. 18- 19

A RESOLUTION TO VACATE A PORTION OF ROCK CREEK ROAD BETWEEN LOUISIANA ROAD AND
EISENHOWER ROAD IN FRANKLIN COUNTY, KANSAS

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Commission authorized notice of proposed vacation of a portion of Rock Creek Road between Louisiana Road and Eisenhower Road described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the center line of Rock Creek Road 20 feet east of the SW corner of Sec 22, Township 17S, Range 19E, thence east along said center line to a point 25 feet west of the SE corner of Sec 22, Township 17S, Range 19E, located in Franklin County, KS.

WHEREAS, the Notice of Public Hearing was published in the official county newspaper on April 14, 2018, and

WHEREAS, notice of the proposed vacation was mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested, to all landowners of record as required by K.S.A. 68-102 notifying said landowners of the proposed vacation and of their right to protest said vacation; and,

WHEREAS, a hearing was held on April 25, 2018 for anyone wishing to protest the vacation of said particular road; and,


BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED
BY
THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY

That the following road is not a public utility by reason of neglect, non-use, or inconvenience and that said road has become practically impassable and the necessity for said road as a public utility does not justify the expenditure of the necessary funds to repair said road or put the same in condition for public travel and therefore said road is hereby vacated as follows:

Beginning at a point on the center line of Rock Creek Road 20 feet east of the SW corner of Sec 22, Township 17S, Range 19E, thence east along said center line to a point 25 feet west of the SE corner of Sec 22, Township 17S, Range 19E, located in Franklin County, KS.

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect following its passage by the Board of County Commissioners and its subsequent publication in the official county newspaper.

WHEREUPON, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Kansas, passes and adopts this Resolution in regular session, at its chambers in Ottawa, Franklin County, Kansas, this 25th day of April 2018.
