RESOLUTION NO. 07- 058

WHEREAS, the intersection of Riley Road with Indiana Road in rural Franklin County, Kansas, is formed by the convergence of a minor north-south road, viz. Indiana Road, and a minor east-west road, viz. Riley Road; and

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 8-2002, authorizes local authorities, including counties, to designate any highway as a through highway or designate any intersection or junction of roadways as a stop or yield intersection or junction, and

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 8-2008, authorizes local authorities to erect and maintain stop signs, yield signs, or other official traffic-control devices upon highways under their jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, Section 2B-5, Number 1, of the *Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices*, provides for the placement of a stop sign where the application of the normal right-of-way is unduly hazardous; and

WHEREAS, a traffic study indicates that sight distance for traffic on the northeast quadrant of the intersection of Riley Road and Indiana Road is limited by vegetation, and

IT IS THEREFORE recommended that a stop sign for westbound traffic on Riley Road be installed at the intersection of Indiana Road and Riley Road.

THAT the Board of County Commissioners hereby directs that a stop sign for westbound traffic on Riley Road be installed at the intersection of Indiana Road and Riley Road.

This resolution shall be in full force and effect following its adoption and publication in the official county newspaper, and the actual installation of the aforescribed stop sign.
