RESOLUTION NO. 19- 21

WHEREAS, the intersection of Sand Creek Road with Utah Road in rural Franklin County, Kansas, is formed by the convergence of a minor east-west road *viz.* Sand Creek Road, and a minor north-south road, *viz.* Utah Road; and

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 8-2002, authorizes local authorities, including counties, to designate any highway as a through highway or designate any intersection or junction of roadways as a stop or yield intersection or junction, and

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 8-2008, authorizes local authorities to erect and maintain stop signs, yield signs, or other official traffic-control devices upon highways under their jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 8-2003, Section 5B.02 1B, of the *Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices*, provides for the placement of a stop sign at an intersection that has restricted sight distance for the prevailing vehicle speeds; and

IT IS THEREFORE recommended that a stop signs for the northbound and the southbound traffic on Utah Road be installed at the intersection of Sand Creek Road and Utah Road.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

THAT the Board of County Commissioners hereby directs that stop signs for the northbound and the southbound traffic on Utah Road be installed at the intersection of Sand Creek Road and Utah Road in Sections 18 and 20, Township 16 South, Rane 21 East of the Sixth PM., in Franklin County, Kansas.

This resolution shall be in full force and effect following its adoption and publication in the official county newspaper, and the actual installation of the aforescribed stop sign.
