**COVID 19 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, on the 18th day of March, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Kansas declared there was a state of local public health emergency in Franklin County, Kansas resulting in the potential or occurring Pandemic known as COVID 19, in Franklin County, Kansas; and

**WHEREAS**, such conditions endanger the public health, safety and welfare of persons within the borders of Franklin County, Kansas.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Kansas:

That the state of local public health emergency in Franklin County, Kansas declared on the 14th day of March, 2020, shall continue and remain in effect for an additional 60 days from this date unless terminated earlier.

That the response and recovery aspects of all local disaster plans which are applicable to Franklin County, Kansas and shall initiate the rendering of aid and assistance there under.

That any rights or powers lawfully exercised or any actions taken pursuant to local disaster emergency plans shall continue and have full force and effect as authorized by law for an additional 60 days unless modified or terminated in the manner prescribed by law.


