

RESOLUTION #20-15

COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on the 8th day of July, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Kansas, declare that there continues to be a state of local public health emergency in Franklin County, Kansas, resulting in the potential or reoccurring pandemic known as COVID-19, in Franklin County, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, such conditions began on March 14th, 2020, and continue to endanger the public health, safety and welfare of persons within the borders of Franklin County, Kansas.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Kansas:

That the state of local public health emergency in Franklin County, Kansas, declared on the 15th day of May, 2020, and extended for 60 days on the 20th day of May, 2020, shall continue to remain in effect until rescinded by the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Kansas.

That the response and recovery aspects of all local disaster plans which are applicable to Franklin County, Kansas, shall initiate the rendering of aid and assistance there under.

That any rights or powers lawfully exercised or any actions taken pursuant to local disaster emergency plans shall continue and have full force and effect as authorized by law until rescinded unless modified or terminated in the manner prescribed by law.
