



A RESOLUTION TO VACATE HAMILTON TERRACE BETWEEN TENNESSEE ROAD AND TEXAS ROAD IN FRANKLIN COUNTY, KS

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Commission authorized notice of proposed vacation of Hamilton Terrace from the east right-of-way of Tennessee Road to the west right-of-way of Texas Road in Section 1, T18S, R20E in Franklin County Kansas.

WHEREAS, the Notice of Public Hearing was published in the official county newspaper on June 26, 2021 and July 3, 2021; and,

WHEREAS, notice of the proposed vacation was mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested, to all landowners of record as required by K.S.A. 68-102 notifying said landowners of the proposed vacation and of their right to protest said vacation; and,

WHEREAS, a hearing was held on July 7, 2021 for anyone wishing to protest the vacation of said particular road; and,


**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED

That the following road is not a public utility by reason of neglect, non-use, or inconvenience and that said road has become practically impassable and the necessity for said road as a public utility does not justify the expenditure of the necessary funds to repair said road or put the same in condition for public travel and therefore said road is hereby vacated as follows:


Beginning on the east right-of-way of Tennessee Road to the west right-of-way of Texas Road in Section 1, T18S, R20E in Franklin County Kansas.
