**A RESOLUTION OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, KANSAS TO EXCEED THE REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE IN ITS PROPERTY TAX LEVY FOR THE TAX YEAR OF 2022**

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners is statutorily required to provide notice and hearing prior to exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Clerk provided notice of the hearing on the Revenue Neutral Rate on August 28, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the Revenue Neutral Rate for tax year 2022 for Franklin County was calculated as 58.064 mills by the County Clerk; and

**WHEREAS**, the budget proposed by the Franklin County Commission for tax year 2022 will require the levy of a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Commission held a hearing on September 8, 2021 allowing all interested taxpayers an opportunity to be heard at the hearing; and

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Commission having heard testimony, have determined that it is in the best interests of Franklin County to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate.

**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED**



Franklin County shall levy a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate of 57.440 mills for Tax Year 2022.
