**RESOLUTION NO. 22- 10**

**A RESOLUTION TO VACATE A PORTION OF ALABAMA ROAD BETWEEN THOMAS ROAD AND WOODSON ROAD IN FRANKLIN COUNTY, KANSAS**

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Commission authorized notice of proposed vacation of Alabama Road from a point 544 feet north of the Southwest Corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section 23, Township 15 South, Range 17 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian to the Northwest Corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 23 in Franklin County, Kansas; and

**WHEREAS**, the Notice of Public Hearing was published in the official county newspaper on March 8<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, notice of the proposed vacation was mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested, to all landowners of record as required by K.S.A. 68-102 notifying said landowners of the proposed vacation and of their right to protest said vacation; and

**WHEREAS**, a hearing was held on March 16, 2022 for anyone wishing to protest the vacation of said particular road; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY  
THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY**

That the following road is not a public utility by reason of neglect, non-use, or inconvenience and that said road has become practically impassable and the necessity for said road as a public utility does not justify the expenditure of the necessary funds to repair said road or put the same in condition for public travel and therefore said road is hereby vacated as follows:

Beginning 544 feet north of the Southwest Corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section 23, Township 15 South, Range 17 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian to the Northwest Corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 23 in Franklin County, Kansas.
