



**A RESOLUTION REPEALING AND RESCINDING FRANKLIN COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 20-15, A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY;**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners is authorized, pursuant to K.S.A. 2020 Supp. 48-932, to declare a state of local disaster emergency upon a finding that a disaster has occurred or the threat thereof is imminent within Franklin County; and

**WHEREAS**, on the 8th day of July, 2020, under Resolution #20-15 the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Kansas, declared that there continued to be a state of local public health emergency in Franklin County, Kansas, resulting in the potential or occurring pandemic known as COVID 19 in Franklin County, Kansas; and

**WHEREAS**, such conditions began on March 14th, 2020, and that the pandemic has moved to an endemic state within the borders of Franklin County, Kansas.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY  
THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY**

That the state of local public health emergency in Franklin County, Kansas, declared on the 8th day of July, 2020, under Resolution #20-15 shall be repealed and rescinded by the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Kansas.

That the response and recovery aspects of the COVID 19 response within Franklin County shall move to normalized operations.

That any rights or powers lawfully exercised or any actions taken pursuant to the local public health emergency shall now be terminated as prescribed by law.
