Proclamation

22-02

WHEREAS, the members of Franklin County EMS and other Emergency Medical Services teams are ready to provide life-saving care to those in need 24 hours a day, seven days a week; and

WHEREAS, access to quality emergency care dramatically improves the survival and recovery rate of those who experience sudden illness or injury; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Medical Services system in Franklin County consists of emergency medical dispatchers, first responders, emergency medical technicians, paramedics; and

WHEREAS, the members of these emergency medical teams engage in multiple hours of specialized training and continued education to enhance the skills necessary to care for the ill and injured; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to recognize the value and accomplishments of these highly trained frontline professionals;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS formally designates May 15th through May 21st, 2022, as

Emergency Medical Services Week

with the theme, "EMS: Rising to the Challenge" and encourage the citizens and communities of Franklin County to honor our responders that week.
