



A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A FEE SCHEDULE FOR MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE AND CONSTRUCTION & DEMOLITION WASTE AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION 13-42

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 19-01, provides that a county may exercise the powers of home rule to determine its local affairs and government authorization under the provisions of K.S.A. 19-101a; and

WHEREAS, the County has experienced an increase in operational costs and finds it necessary to increase fees charged by the County for municipal solid waste and construction & demolitions waste; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners believes that this is in the best interests of the County to adopt a new fee schedule effective September 1, 2022.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY
THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY**

That the following resolution replaces Franklin County Resolution 13-42 and establishes a new fee schedule for the Franklin County Landfill effective September 1, 2022.

- Municipal Solid Waste: \$49.00 per ton with a \$10.00 minimum
- Construction & Demolition Waste: \$39.00 per ton with a \$10.00 minimum
- White Goods: Free
- White Goods with Freon: \$20.00 each
- Leaves and Grass for Compost: Free
- Brush: \$28.00 per ton
- Tires:
 - Passenger Tires: \$3.50 per tire
 - Passenger Tire on Rim: \$7.00 per tire
 - Truck Tire: \$8.00 per tire
 - Truck Tire on Rim: \$16.00
 - Tractor Tire: \$30.00 per tire
 - Tractor Tire on Rim: Not Allowed
 - Tires from a Business: \$180.00 per ton
 - 15 or more Tires: \$180.00 per ton

This Resolution rescinds and replaces all other former resolutions relating to fees charged at the Franklin County Transfer Station in Franklin County, Kansas.

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect following its passage by the Board of County Commissioners and its subsequent publication in the official county newspaper.
