



**A RESOLUTION TO ADD SPEED LIMITS WITHIN THE WALNUT CREEK ACRES SUBDIVISION,  
PHASES 1 THROUGH 5 IN FRANKLIN COUNTY, KANSAS**

**WHEREAS**, K.S.A. 8-1560(h) authorizes local authorities who have jurisdiction over County roads and highways to determine, based on engineering and traffic investigation or without an engineering and traffic investigation, the proper maximum speed for such County roads and highways and to declare a reasonable and safe maximum limit thereon; and

**WHEREAS**, Walnut Creek Acres, Walnut Creek Acres Second Plat, Walnut Creek Acres Third Plat, Walnut Creek Acres Fourth Plat and Walnut Creek Acres Fifth Plat are residential areas; and

**WHEREAS**, Walnut Creek Acres, Walnut Creek Acres Second Plat, Walnut Creek Acres Third Plat, Walnut Creek Acres Fourth Plat and Walnut Creek Acres Fifth Plat contain a number of dwellings whose residents include children; and

**WHEREAS**, a survey conducted by the Franklin County Public Works Department has determined that, due to the amount of children residing in the above described area are at play on, over and near the County roads within the above described subdivisions; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY  
THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY**

Section 1. The maximum speed for vehicular traffic on the roads within the Walnut Creek Acres, Walnut Creek Acres Second Plat, Walnut Creek Acres Third Plat, Walnut Creek Acres Fourth Plat and Walnut Creek Acres Fifth Plat is thirty (30) miles per hour.

Section 2. The Franklin County Public Works Department is directed to post signage in this subdivision in accordance with Kansas State Law and applicable rules and regulations of the Kansas Department of Transportation.

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect following its passage by the Board of County Commissioners, publication in the official County newspaper and the actual installation of the above described signs. This resolution shall remain in effect until future action is taken by the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners.
