



A RESOLUTION OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, KANSAS TO EXCEED THE REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE IN ITS PROPERTY TAX LEVY FOR THE TAX YEAR OF 2023

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners is statutorily required to provide notice and hearing prior to exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Clerk provided notice of the hearing on the Revenue Neutral Rate on August 23, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Revenue Neutral Rate for tax year 2023 for Franklin County was calculated as 52.567 mills by the County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the budget proposed by the Franklin County Commission for tax year 2023 will require the levy of a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Commission held a hearing on September 7, 2022 allowing all interested taxpayers an opportunity to be heard at the hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Commission having heard testimony, have determined that it is in the best interests of Franklin County to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate.

**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED
BY
THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY**

Franklin County shall levy a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate of 53.843 mills for Tax Year 2023.

This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and shall remain in effect until future action is taken by the Franklin County Commission.
