**A RESOLUTION TO VACATE A PORTION OF FINNEY ROAD EAST OF TEXAS ROAD IN
FRANKLIN COUNTY, KANSAS**

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Commission authorized notice of proposed vacation of Finney Road right of way beginning 206 feet East of the Southwest Corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section 18, Township 18 South, Range 21 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Franklin County, Kansas; Thence East approximately 2,023 feet to the Southeast Corner of said Southwest Quarter. This portion of Finney Road is currently a minimum maintenance road.

WHEREAS, the Notice of Public Hearing was published in the official county newspaper on March 6th and 13th, 2024; and

WHEREAS, notice of the proposed vacation was mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested, to all landowners of record as required by K.S.A. 68-102 notifying said landowners of the proposed vacation and of their right to protest said vacation; and

WHEREAS, a hearing was held on March 20, 2024 for anyone wishing to protest the vacation of said particular road; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY
THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY**

That the following road is not a public utility by reason of neglect, non-use, or inconvenience and that said road has become practically impassable and the necessity for said road as a public utility does not justify the expenditure of the necessary funds to repair said road or put the same in condition for public travel and therefore said road is hereby vacated as follows:

Beginning 206 feet East of the Southwest Corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section 18, Township 18 South, Range 21 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Franklin County, Kansas; Thence East approximately 2,023 feet to the Southeast Corner of said Southwest Quarter.
