RESOLUTION NO. 25-03

A Resolution Promulgating the Franklin County Emergency Operations Plan (CEOP) and the Franklin County Local Recovery Plan

Whereas, Franklin County recognizes the importance of planning for major emergencies and disasters to protect the lives and property of our community; and

Whereas, the development and implementation of an Emergency Operations Plan (CEOP) will ensure the effective coordination and integration of efforts to respond to and recover from emergencies and disasters; and

Whereas, the development of the Franklin County Local Recovery Plan is critical to ensuring that recovery operations are well-organized and that the county can return to normal or improved levels following a disaster; and

Whereas, K.S.A. 48-929 requires counties to develop and promulgate a County Emergency Operations Plan as part of their emergency preparedness efforts; and

Whereas, the Franklin County Local Recovery Plan outlines the recovery strategies and procedures for the county to follow in the event of a disaster; and

Whereas, the Franklin County Emergency Operations Plan (CEOP) and the Franklin County Local Recovery Plan have been developed to provide elected officials, appointed personnel, government departments, and private and volunteer agencies with the necessary policies, guidance, and procedures for a coordinated response and recovery from emergencies and disasters; and

Whereas, the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners has reviewed both the Emergency Operations Plan (CEOP) and the Franklin County Local Recovery Plan, and has approved them for implementation contingent upon this formal promulgation by the governing body; and

Whereas, Franklin County desires to comply with state law and enhance its emergency management and recovery efforts by formally promulgating both the County Emergency Operations Plan (CEOP) and the Franklin County Local Recovery Plan; and

Whereas, promulgation of these plans demonstrates the jurisdiction's commitment to fulfilling the goals and objectives outlined within each plan, and

Whereas, promulgation of these plans authorizes responsible agencies to carry out their duties as outlined in the CEOP and Local Recovery Plan.

Now, therefore, be it resolved, that Franklin County promulgates the County Emergency Operations Plan (CEOP) and the Franklin County Local Recovery Plan as official plans; and

Be it further resolved, Franklin County will submit this Promulgation Resolution to the appropriate state authorities to enable both plans' final approval.
