Proclamation

25 – 08

In the County/State of Franklin County, Kansas, in recognition of the critical work being done by domestic violence advocates and allies in service of the survivors and the victims they serve, we encourage all citizens to actively engage in the scheduled activities and events sponsored by The Willow Domestic Violence Center and other organizations working toward the eradication of domestic violence;

Whereas, in the United States, 10 to 12 million adults experience domestic violence annually, with an average of 20 people every minute experiencing these heinous acts.

Whereas, in the state of Kansas, one domestic violence incident occurs every 23 minutes, and one domestic violence murder occurs every 11 days, with one domestic violence arrest made every 46 minutes.

Whereas, the impact of domestic violence is felt not only by individuals and families but also by communities and a nation as a whole;

Whereas, Franklin County joins with others across the state of Kansas and nationwide in supporting domestic violence victims and survivors, the advocates and organizations who serve them, and holding offenders accountable in our community;

Now Therefore, the Franklin County Board of Commissioners hereby do proclaim October 2025 as Domestic Violence Awareness Month.


