
THEREUPON, the Court indicated that counsel for the parties had met off the record, prior to the hearing, to discuss hearing dates and a proposed schedule. The Court, at the request of the parties, set this matter down for the following dates and events: August 29, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. for status/motion hearing, October 17, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. for status/motion hearing, December 19, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. for status/motion hearing, January 16, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. for status/motion hearing, and February 24 and 25, 2014 at 9:00 a.m. for preliminary hearing.

THEREUPON, the Court took up State's Motion #1, Motion to File Pleadings Under Seal. Defense counsel did not object to State's Motion #1. The Court, after hearing argument, indicated that it was denying State's Motion #1 and would not issue a blanket seal. The Court indicated that parties were free to file individual motions under seal, and the Court would make a determination as to each motion and whether or not it should remain under seal.

THEREUPON, the Court took up State's Motion #2, Motion to Perform DNA Testing. Defense counsel objected to State's Motion #2 and argued against any testing that would consume/destroy a DNA sample. The parties presented argument and the Court took the matter under advisement. The Court indicated that it would issue a written decision/ruling later in the week.
