

**BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
FRANKLIN COUNTY, KANSAS**

RESOLUTION NO: 14- 04

A RESOLUTION ALTERING COMMISSION DISTRICTS PURSUANT TO K.S.A. 19-204(a)

WHEREAS, the Board of Franklin County Commissioners shall meet and review the commission districts for possible alteration at least once every three years;

WHEREAS, the Board of Franklin County Commissioners has reviewed the current commission districts and finds that it is necessary to alter the districts to form more compact and equal districts;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that it is necessary to modify the precinct boundaries in the City of Ottawa to make the necessary alterations to commission districts;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that pursuant to K.S.A. 25-26a02 the county election officer shall submit maps of the precincts to the Secretary of State thirty days prior to the precinct boundaries becoming effective.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Kansas finds that the districts shall be altered as set out in the map designated as Attachment "A" to this resolution and as set forth in this resolution as follows:

- District One: Second Precinct, Ottawa City; Sixth Precinct, Ottawa City; Seventh Precinct, Ottawa City.
- District Two: Eight Precinct, Ottawa City; Lincoln Township; Homewood Township; Richmond Township; Williamsburg Township.
- District Three: First Precinct, Ottawa City; Appanoose Township; Centropolis Township; Greenwood Township; Hayes Township; Pomona Township; Ottawa Township.
- District Four: Third Precinct, Ottawa City; Fourth Precinct, Ottawa City; Harrison Township; Ohio Township
- District Five: Cutler Township; Franklin Township; Peoria Township; Pottawatomie Township.

This alteration to form more compact and equal districts requires alteration of the precinct boundaries within the City of Ottawa. In addition, the Commission finds that efficiency warrants consolidating Ottawa Precinct 4 and Ottawa Precinct 5 which shall hereafter be Ottawa Precinct 4. The County Clerk, as Election Officer for Franklin County, pursuant to K.S.A. 25-26a04 shall submit the revised precinct maps to the Secretary of State on or before February 7, 2014 for review. The new boundaries for the Commission districts and changes to the precinct boundaries, absent objection from the Secretary of State's office shall become effective on March 12, 2014.

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its publication in the official county newspaper.
