RESOLUTION NO. 14- 27

WHEREAS, the intersection of Old 59 Highway with Stafford Road in rural Franklin County, Kansas, is formed by the convergence of a major east-west road *viz.* Stafford Road, and a minor north-south road, *viz.* Old 59 Highway; and

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 8-2002, authorizes local authorities, including counties, to designate any highway as a through highway or designate any intersection or junction of roadways as a stop or yield intersection or junction, and

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 8-2008, authorizes local authorities to erect and maintain stop signs, yield signs, or other official traffic-control devices upon highways under their jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 8-2003, Section 2B-5, Number 1, of the *Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices*, provides for the placement of a stop sign where the application of the normal right-of-way is unduly hazardous; and

IT IS THEREFORE recommended that the stop signs for eastbound and westbound Stafford Road be removed.

THAT the Board of County Commissioners hereby directs that the stop signs for eastbound and westbound Stafford Road be removed.

This resolution shall be in full force and effect following its adoption and publication in the official county newspaper, and the actual removal of the afore described stop signs.
