**RESOLUTION NO. 12-15**

A RESOLUTION TO VACATE A CERTAIN ROAD IN FRANKLIN COUNTY, KANSAS

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Commission authorized notice of proposed vacation of Utah Road from the Southeast corner of the NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 7, Township 17S, Range 21E South, in Franklin County, Kansas; and,

WHEREAS, notice of the proposed vacation was mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested, to all landowners of record as required by K.S.A. 68-102 notifying said landowners of the proposed vacation and of their right to protest said vacation; and,

WHEREAS, a hearing was held on May 7, 2012, for anyone wishing to protest the vacation of said particular road; and,

WHEREAS, as a result of said hearing, the Franklin County Commission voted to vacate the portion of said road above described.

**NOW BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY  
THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, KANSAS**

That the following road is not a public utility by reason of neglect, non-use, or inconvenience and that said road has become practically impassable and the necessity for said road as a public utility does not justify the expenditure of the necessary funds to repair said road or put the same in condition for public travel and therefore said road is hereby vacated:

Utah Road from the Southeast corner of the NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 7, Township 17S, Range 21E South to 25 feet south of the steel truss bridge, Franklin County, Kansas.

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect following its passage by the Board of County Commissioners and its subsequent publication in the official county newspaper.

WHEREUPON, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Kansas, passes and adopts this Resolution in regular session, at its chambers in Ottawa, Franklin County, Kansas, this 30<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2012.
