WHEREAS, the City of Ottawa has proposed the renewal of a ½ cent sales tax and the addition of ½ cent to the voters of the City of Ottawa; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Commission has seen the value and benefit to its taxpayers living in the City of Ottawa from the existing half cent through property tax stabilization, consistent funding of necessary city services; and the measured and prudent extension of infrastructure; and


