RESOLUTION NO: 11-10

A RESOLUTION RESCINDING DISBANDING THE CONVENTION AND TOURISM COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 19-101, a county may exercise the powers of home rule to determine its local affairs and government authorization under the provisions of K.S.A. 19-101a; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-16,101 a County Commission that levies a transient guest tax may establish a convention and tourism committee to make recommendations concerning programs and expenditures for the promotion of conventions and tourism;

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-16,101the board of county commissioners shall have the authority to contract for convention and tourism programs to be implemented;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined it is the best interest of Franklin County to contract for convention and tourism programs.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined that it is inefficient and unnecessary to have a committee to oversee the convention and tourism function and to contract for tourism and convention services; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined that it is in the best interest of Franklin County to disband the current Convention and Tourism Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County do hereby disband the Convention and Tourism Committee established by Franklin County Resolution 84-28.

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect following its adoption and publication in the official county newspaper.
