RESOLUTION NO. 17- 27

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 8-1560(h) authorizes local authorities who have jurisdiction over County roads and highway to determine, based on engineering and traffic investigation or without an engineering and traffic investigation, the proper maximum speed for such County roads and highways and to declare a reasonable and safe maximum limit thereon; and

WHEREAS, Wheatland Farms Subdivision is a residential area; and

WHEREAS, Wheatland Farms Subdivision contains a number of dwellings whose residents include children; and

WHEREAS, a survey conducted by the Franklin County Public Works Department has determined that, due to the amount of children residing in the above described area are at play on, over and near the above described portions of County roads; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, KANSAS

Section 1. The maximum speed for vehicular traffic in Wheatland Farms Subdivision roads is thirty (30) miles per hour.

Section 2. The Franklin County Public Works Department is directed to post signage in this subdivision in accordance with Kansas State Law and applicable rules and regulations of the Kansas Department of Transportation.

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect following its adoption, publication in the official County newspaper and the actual installation of the above described signs.
