RESOLUTION NO. 08-038

WHEREAS, the intersection of Woodson Road and Louisiana Terrace in rural Franklin County, Kansas, is formed by the convergence of a minor north-south road, viz Louisiana Terrace, and a minor east-west road, viz. Woodson Road; and

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 8-2002, authorizes local authorities, including counties, to designate any highway as a through highway or designate any intersection or junction of roadways as a stop or yield intersection or junction, and

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 8-2008, authorizes local authorities to erect and maintain stop signs, yield signs, or other official traffic-control devices upon highways under their jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, Section 2B-5, Number 1, of the *Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices*, provides for the placement of a stop sign where the application of the normal right-of-way is unduly hazardous; and

IT IS THEREFORE recommended that a stop sign for northbound traffic on Louisiana Terrace be installed at the intersection of Woodson Road and Louisiana Terrace.

THAT the Board of County Commissioners hereby directs that a stop sign for northbound traffic on Louisiana Terrace be installed at the intersection of Woodson Road and Louisiana Terrace.

This resolution shall be in full force and effect following its adoption and publication in the official county newspaper, and the actual installation of the aforescribed stop sign.
