

ITEM: Consider Mr. Blacks request for relief from flooding north of Neosho Road east of the driveway to 3159 Neosho Road

Background: I met with Mr. Black at 3159 Neosho Road last spring. He stated that since the I-35 ramp was relocated that his property is receiving much more water and the ditch on Neosho was inadequate to carry the run off. We discussed enlarging the ditch and using the material to fill the erosion in the field resulting from the runoff. We also discussed the need for a landowner agreement if work was to be performed off the right of way, a pocket of silt and a break in the back slope. Mr. Hamlin looked at the area and had the silt removed and placed the silt in the break in the back slope. I discussed the situation with Mr. Black on two occasions and explained in my opinion, since the field was below the top of the opening of the driveway structure that enlarging the ditch would not achieve the solution he desired and the silt removal and back slope repair was all that the Department would accomplish. Mr. Black is not satisfied with that determination.

Recommended Action: View the site and determine if further work is the Counties responsibility.
