ITEM: Discuss waiving the purchasing policy and approving an agreement with Tank Tech to clean the Diesel Tank in the estimated amount of \$6,798.50.

Background: The Diesel fuel tank has been treated twice for fungus growth in the tank and the resulting sediment is clogging fuel filters for the Ambulance Department and Public Works. Tank Tech was recommended by our vendor for the control system as the only firm performing this service.

Recommended Action: Discuss waiving the purchasing policy and approving an agreement with Tank Tech to clean the Diesel Tank in the estimated amount of \$6,798.50

The above price does NOT include the following:

Pumping tank free from product, permits, tightness testing, special testing (if required), tank bottom sludge disposal and/or additional repairs and delays caused by customer. For every additional day the crew is required to remain on site because of extra repairs or delays beyond the scope of work, additional per diem will be charged.

Rock Clause:

In the event rock, water or unstable backfill are encountered during excavation, additional labor shall be performed at our standard time and material rate.

Equipment Clause:

Contractors will not be responsible for electronic equipment, gauges, monitors, valves, etc. not removed prior to the start of work.

Liability Clause:

Tank Tech assumes no responsibility in the event of cave in of excavation or resulting damages to any adjacent buildings and/or structures on premises or in the event of accidental floatation.

Utilities: *Prior to the start of the installation, the Customer will have all underground utilities visibly marked on the location property and adjoining right of way. Failure to have the utilities located prior to installation will release contractor of responsibility for any damage done to any underground structures while performing the Scope of Work as attached.*

Right to reject tanks:

Any UST's that do not meet structural integrity standards may be rejected for lining and a turn down fee for time and material charged. The amount of this charge may be determined prior to commencement of work.

Taxes:

Applicable federal, state and local taxes are not included in the quoted price and will be added to the final invoice when applicable.

Results/Documentation/Paperwork:

Complete project information, compliance documentation and warranty (when applicable) will be provided upon receipt of payment. Customer is responsible for collection fees, court costs and reasonable attorney fees to collect unpaid accounts.

"Scope of work" and "Terms and Conditions" shall be signed by the customer and will become part of the contract entered into by the Contractor and the Customer.
