ITEM:

Approval of the Federal Recovery Act – Edward Byrne Memorial – Justice Assistance Grant for fiscal year 2010 in the amount of \$28,395

Background:

On June 4, 2009 the Fourth Judicial District Community Corrections participated in a technical assistance session sponsored by the Kansas Department of Corrections (KDOC). The purpose of this session was to provide insight and guidance regarding the completion of the FY2010 Federal Recovery Act – Edward Byrne Memorial – Justice Assistance Grant. The KDOC recently announced a potential 6% budget reduction for FY2010 and wanted to encourage judicial districts to apply for this grant to offset potential shortfalls in personnel that would negatively impact the district's ability to continue with its previously established risk reduction efforts.

As a result Community Corrections is in the process of writing this grant, which will be submitted to the Board of County Commissioners prior to June 17, 2009. The deadline for the grant is June 16, 2009; however, Community Corrections has received permission from the Governor's Grants Program to submit the program certifications after the deadline with the understanding that all the remaining documents will be submitted prior to the deadline. The completed grant shall be forwarded to the BOCC immediately upon completion.
