Franklin County has been awarded \$504,000 of ARRA Funds to construct a 2" overlay on John Brown Road between Kentucky Road and Florida Road. The plans have been prepared by KDOT staff from the Area office and the project is scheduled for the July letting.

Franklin County is requesting proposals to perform construction inspection for the overlay project which has (15) fifteen working days. The inspection is to be performed in accordance with the rules and guidelines developed for the current KDOT approved construction engineering program. The Consultant selected must complete the Recovery Act monthly employment reporting requirements and comply with the Recovery Act auditing requirements.

Three copies of your firm's proposal should be received by my office prior to July 8, 2009. The proposal should indicate the employees who would be assigned, their experience, certifications, qualifications and other information that would be relevant to this project
