**ITEM: Accept the bid as submitted by Lifeline Emergency Vehicles for a new ambulance.**

Background: At the September 30, 2009 commission meeting the Commission opened bids for a new ambulance from Lifeline Emergency Vehicles and Murphy's Fire and Rescue. The matter was tabled to allow time for staff to determine if the bids met specifications and to report back to the Commission. After reviewing the bids, it is staff's findings that the bid from Murphy's Fire and Rescue did not meet the bid specifications and fails to include the Stryker power cot or the Stryker stair chair per the bid request. The bid from Lifeline Emergency Vehicles does meet the specifications set forth in the amount of \$148,954.00.

Recommended Action: It is recommended that Franklin County accept the bid from Lifeline Emergency Vehicles as the responsible and low bid in this matter.
