1. Inspection Application forms are available at the Franklin County Environmental Health Department, 1428 South Main Street, Suite #6, Ottawa, Kansas.
2. Filing Fees for a Resale Wastewater Stabilization Pond (Lagoon) Inspection is \$150.00
3. A minimum of twenty-four (24) hours notice is required to schedule a Resale Wastewater Stabilization Pond (Lagoon) Inspection.
4. The Owner or Applicant should be present during the inspection.
5. Access to the residence for inspection of plumbing, etc. must be available at the time of the inspection.
6. Inspections will be conducted only during normal working hours – Monday through Friday – 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., except for holidays.
7. The inspection report shall be made available within forty-eight (48) hours of the inspection.
