H1N1 Vaccine is available to

- All individuals. No Charge.

Seasonal Vaccine

- Special cash fee is \$15.00. Also accept Medicare

*Children under age 10 who need their second dose of influenza or H1N1 should call to verify the appropriate date before coming to a clinic or have the record from the first dose with them. No second doses will be given before a full 30 days has passed. If requesting nasal mist, the child cannot have had another live virus vaccine in the last thirty days. **No** "Vaccine For Children", the state program for uninsured and underinsured will be available at this clinic.*
