Franklin County Substance Use Prevention Coalition believes we can impact our community by giving them hope to pursue a different path than they may have experienced within their family or friends. We need to raise awareness of the addictive nature of these substances and the opioids being distributed on the streets, including fentanyl (100 times more potent than morphine), which has been laced with other substances. Our community members have been offered substances (ex: a pill or joint), and they have no idea what is in it, which is extremely dangerous. Due to these behaviors, our community is losing lives. Our coalition mission is to teach our community about this risk and show the individuals they are valued, and that their life is worth living!
