FRANKLIN COUNTY, KS – The Franklin County Health Officer, Dr. Bud Ransom, has suspended classroom and extracurricular activities for all Franklin County Schools for two weeks, starting on March 16, 2020. The COVID-19 outbreak is being taken seriously by Franklin County and all response partners. At the end of the two-week period, public health and school officials will reevaluate the situation.

The Franklin County Public Health Department continues to closely monitor the COVID-19 outbreak and is working with the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE), as well as other Franklin County agencies to manage the situation.
