

NOTICE OF GENERAL QUESTION ELECTION
TO ALL THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF PRINCETON, KANSAS:

Notice is hereby given by the Governing Body of the City of Princeton and the county election officer of Franklin County, Kansas, that there will be a general election in the City of Princeton on the 3rd day of March, 2026, including for the purpose of voting on the question of levying a city retailers' sales tax in the amount of one-half percent (0.50%) on retail sales consummated with in the City of Princeton, Kansas, for general purposes including funding an adequate level of public services and avoiding reliance on property taxes in accordance with K.S.A. 12-187 et seq., and amendments thereto. If approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon, such tax will take effect on the 1st day of July 2026, and shall be collected by the state department of revenue, and the revenue therefrom returned to the City of Princeton.

Notice is further given that the polls will be opened for voting between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on said date at the following places: Princeton Community Building.

The proposition shall appear on the ballot as follows:

Shall the following be adopted?

Shall the City of Princeton, Kansas ("City") be authorized to levy a retailers' sales tax in the amount of one-half percent (0.50%) within the City, and to use the revenue from the tax in whole or in part for general purposes, including but not limited to:

- (a) to fund street infrastructure improvements including the maintenance and rebuilding of roads, sidewalks, storm water facilities, and street lighting;**
- (b) the improving, rebuilding, and maintaining of city utility infrastructure;**
- (c) funding general government operations to limit reliance on property taxes; and**
- (d) all things related and necessary to construct and finance such projects including bonds and other obligations.**

Provided that such tax shall take effect July 1, 2026, or as soon thereafter as the Kansas Department of Revenue may begin collecting such tax.
